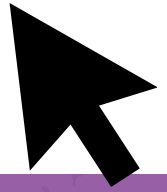

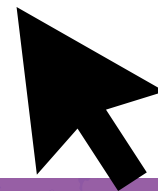

# General Advice for Applicants

Work hard in school to gain the best exam results you can. Good grades especially in core subjects (e.g., English and maths) are often what employers and/or training providers ask for. If you don't have a grade 4 in English or maths you will be expected to study for this alongside a training programme.

The training providers listed in this booklet may expect you to find your own employer before you can start the apprenticeship qualification. Training providers will usually advise you on how to find an employer, you can contact local companies yourself to ask if they have apprenticeship vacancies. Searching individual company websites, social media or recruitment websites may be helpful. To find a list of employers in a particular job sector you could use [www.yell.com](http://www.yell.com)

Recruitment onto training or apprenticeships could involve completing applications, aptitude tests, basic skills assessments, group or one to one interviews and selection days. Use the list of Useful Websites listed in this booklet to fully prepare.

Apprenticeships can be highly competitive with limited placements in some job sectors. It is a good idea to apply for full-time education courses too as a back-up, a full-time course could allow you more time to develop your skills and qualifications.
