- Reducing caseloads to give Health Visitors opportunity to see families and do targeted and personalised work.
- New Modern Matron-Professional Lead role and clinical psychologist role.
- Three specialist posts of Infant Feeding Coordinator, Perinatal Mental Health and SEND to support 'levelling up' and target areas of health inequality.
- Attaining the UNICEF Baby Friendly award and achieving the Gold Level.
- Providing a 'One Team' approach with integrated pathways connecting to Humber children's services and wider LA and none statutory services.

New model of service delivery

- Health Visiting – 6 universal contacts (antenatal, NBV, 6-8, 3 month (additional contact), 12 month and 2-2.5 years, aligned to national policies and procedures) plus a targeted pre-school review.
- School Nursing- focus on transitions and improved visibility and accessibility in schools.
- The service will provide support to the 16-19 (up to 25 where the young person has additional vulnerabilities) population, through face to face, virtual and text messaging services.



New model of service delivery

- Specialist champions across the service to link in with other specialists across the system and champion the work, develop pathways and work in partnership with key services (some of these champions will co-locate with areas such as midwifery, children's centres, safeguarding).
- Working in collaboration with partners to improve the digital offer, ensuring relevant, up to date health advice and information. Chat Health and e- clinics, dedicated website and social media sites.

- New service that will focus on unintentional injuries and safer sleep, providing specialist training to professionals, targeted work with families, development of strong links with Childrens A&E and key partner services to identify new ways of reducing unintentional injuries.
- Oral Health Promotion will be delivered by Harrogate & District Trust, more schools to receive the supervised tooth brushing, refresh of the oral health referral pathway into Flexible Commissioned Practices (NHSE) and concentration on training to key professionals working with families.




