Classroom culture — The importance of consistent adult behaviour and the small changes that can have huge impacts. How to create the positive classroom culture where children feel safe and eager to engage. Emotional currency what is it any why is it so important within the classroom.

Scripted interventions— What are the root causes of unwanted behaviour. The impact of your response—it is never about winning. Look at the use of language when addressing unwanted behaviour.

PACE training— PACE stands for Playfulness, Acceptance, Curiosity and Empathy. These principles help to promote positive relationships between staff and the young people that they live with and thus enhance their outcomes. Training explores Peaceful approaches with children.

Emotion Coaching - Entails validating children's emotions, setting limits where appropriate and problem-solving with the child to develop more effective behavioural strategies. In effect, emotion coaching techniques instil the tools that will aid children's ability to self-regulate their emotions and behaviour.
