## What Are SEND IAS Services?

SEND IAS Services are:

- **Statutory** – every locality must have a SENDIAS Service
- **Free** – you will never be expected to pay for this service
- **Confidential** – we will not share what we talk about with others unless given permission
- **Impartial** – we do not take sides and are ‘at arm’s length’ from all organisations and the Local Authority

You do not need a diagnosis or Education, Health & Care Plan to access a SEND IAS Service.

Hull SENDIASS is the Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) Information, Advice and Support Service for families of children and young people aged 0-25 years with SEND in Hull.
